Just like each club is measured based on the Distinguished Club Program (explained later), every districts earn points when they perform well on some criteria: number of clubs, number of members and number of Distinguished Clubs. All districts are evaluated based on those criteria because those data reveal the district's health. A growing number of members means more participants in your clubs, therefore, a more attractive and functioning club. More clubs means more opportunities for people to develop their skills. And more successful clubs (based on the DCP) means that clubs are growing, attracting new members to always refresh themselves, members are advancing in the program... in a word, clubs are healthy, so the district is healthy.

The Distinguished Club Program

HOW IT WORKS (briefly)

The Distinguished Club Program is an annual program, running from July 1 through June 30. The program consists of for your club to obtain, using the [Club Success Plan](#). At year-end, the number of goals the club achieved is calculated, the goals met and whether or not the qualifying requirement has been met, the club may be recognized as a Distinguished or President's Distinguished Club.

Goals are obtained when:

- Members are advancing in their programs (new levels achieved, either in the traditional program and Pathways)
- New members join the club (1 point for 4 new members, 1 again for the following 4 new members)
- The club officers are trained twice a year
- The club has paid the members' dues on time
